


SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Net Position

The Research Corporation's net position is unrestricted. Unrestricted net position is reported in the accompanying financial statements.

Revenue Recognition

Revenue is recognized when the Company has performed its obligations under the contract, the amount is fixed or determinable, and collection is probable. The Company's contracts are typically non-cancelable and the Company has no refund liability. Revenue is recognized when the Company has performed its obligations under the contract, the amount is fixed or determinable, and collection is probable.

Income Taxes

Revenue from the Company's operations, including related business income, as defined by Section 1361 of the Code, is subject to Federal income tax. In addition, the Research Corporation is not a private foundation based on a determination received from the Internal Revenue Service.

Financial Instruments

The Company's financial instruments consist of cash, accounts receivable, and accounts payable. The Company's financial instruments are carried at cost, which approximates fair value.

Goodwill

Goodwill is the excess of the purchase price over the fair value of the identifiable intangible assets acquired in a business combination. Goodwill is not amortized and is tested for impairment annually.
